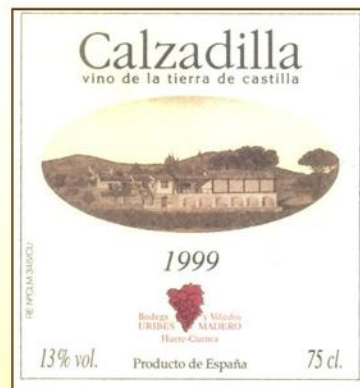


## Calzadilla Red 1999



**50% Tempranillo, 38 % Cabernet Sauvignon,  
12% Garnacha**

The first wine of the house which well reflects the exotic terroir and its remoteness from recognized wine-making regions.

Cherry ruby, intense bouquet of mature fruit and a great variety of spices (clove, peppers and red peppers). Very rich, intense and mature fruit flavours on the palate with oily characteristics, very rounded, almost creamy, and a very long and elegant finish.

### BODEGAS URIBES MADERO

The Estate of Uribes Madero is the result of the marriage and partnership of Francisco Uribes and Celia Madero. Francisco, an architect, runs the business and Celia, a pharmacist, is the oenologist. They are members of *Grandes Pagos de Castilla*. The wine is born and produced in a bucolic part of La Alcarria (Cuenca), an unknown land of woods, rivers and monasteries, and far away from the rules of a Denomination de Origin. The production of wine was typical of the region until phylloxera destroyed the vines in the 19th century. The Uribes Madero dream was to restore the vineyards and the tradition of winemaking to the area.
