

## Château de Callac 2003 Red Graves



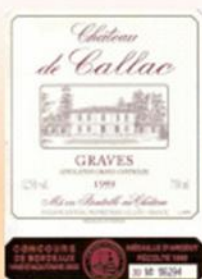
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 50% Merlot

The Château de Callac production is dominated by red wines as well as dry wines which certainly constitutes the best of Bordeaux region. In fact, dry white wines are produced in the Northern part of the area while sweet wines are produced in the southern section.

The eye of Château de Callac is immediately drawn to the wine's attractive, deep purple color with violet rim. Young and lively on the nose with wild berry overtones. The nose is confirmed by the palate. Good structure.



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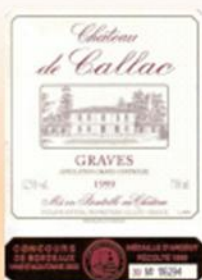
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
