100% Pinot Noir.

Deep ruby red in color with tinges of violet..
The attack is bold with pure fruit and hints of violet and spice (cinnamon) on the palate.
There are also notes of toast, blackberry and blackcurrant. Full, well-rounded tannins give nice length. This wine has a promising future.

The MARCHAND estate has been in existence over seven generations in Morey-St-Denis. In 1983 it was extended with the purchase of an old wine-grower's house -right in the heart of Gevrey-Chambertin.

The MARCHAND estate includes vineyards located in the villages of Chambolle-Musigny, Morey-Saint-Denis, Gevrey-Chambertin featuring some first growths such as Les Sentiers at Chambolle, le Clos des Ormes at Morey, les Combottes at Gevrey, as well as great growths : Clos de la Roche at Morey, Griottes Chambertin and Charmes Chambertin at Gevrey.
