The Vineyard

Owner: Guillaume Reglat. Average age of the vines: 35 years. Production: 15000 bottles per year. Soil: Silicious and chalky-clayey. Ageing: 5 years. Maturing and making. Hand made harvest with selective picking of grapes. Traditional vinification with thermoregulation.



Tasting Notes

Chateau Cousteau is a very delicate desert wine, complex, fruity, well balanced, with honeyed stone fruit flavours, balanced by a refreshing crispness.
