RIESLING 2006



This is a semi-sweet, Kabinett style Riesling with aromas and flavors that hint of peaches and apricots. The sweetness of this wine is beautifully balanced with a crisp, refreshing acidity that lingers on the finish. It is a good partner for summer salads, fruit dishes, or any spicy cuisine.

History:

The Winery was established in 1972 by Lee Smith, one of Oregon's pioneer winemakers, and was originally called Forgeron Vineyard. It is the oldest winery in the South Willamette Valley,

The property was purchased by LaVelle Vineyards in April 1994, by Doug LaVelle who was at the end of his 29 years career with GTE Communication.

After an extensive remodeling, the winery tasting room opened on Memorial Day weekend in 1996.
