



“Old Vines” Maison Galhaud Grenache Noir 2005 Vin de Pays Catalan

This wine is produced from low-yielding vines that average more than 50 years in age. These vines are grown in the far South of France, in the rugged Pyrenees orientales area. Rich, opulent, darkly colored and intensely aromatic, this wine will reveal its complex quality with 3-7 years of additional age.

“It boasts a deep ruby/purple color as well as a big, thick nose of kirsch liqueur intermixed with pepper, spice, earth and black fruit. There is excellent density, full body and a whoppingly rich, concentrated finish. The 15% alcohol is well-hidden by the wine’s abundant fruit. It should evolve and drink well for 5-6 years, perhaps longer.
