



## 2001 Reflections, Kreck Estate Vineyards

73% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc, 12% Merlot

It has aromas of vanilla, herbs, black cherry, brown spice, and smoke, followed by flavors of sweet oak, herbs, brown spice, and smoke. The wine is moderately acidic, slightly astringent (which will soften with age), with a long finish.

The gently rolling hills in North Sonoma County's Alexander Valley are known around the world for the intensely flavored red wine grapes grown on its slopes. Reflections Meritage, a Bordeaux-style blend of varietals grown on the Kreck Estate Vineyard, is a concept originating from a desire to stay closer to home. The vineyards on Chalk Hill Road couldn't be situated any more advantageously for making that dream come true.
