Salmon pink color with grey hints. Nose lightly mineral with notes of peach and citrus.

The 172 hectares of our domain are spread out over the foothills of the Massif des Maures. They are primarily made up of rocky, sun-drenched hillsides which meet all the conditions needed to obtain an Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée, a rare label which testifies to its quality and origin in the Cotes de Provence area.

In 1973 the newly chosen land was planted with the noblest grape varieties, such as Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah, Carignan, Cabernet Sauvignon, Ugni Blanc and Rolle, in order to produce the finest red, white and rose wines.

These grapes separately transformed into wine in our cellars hundred or so vats. We assess the qualities of each variety in order to blend them judiciously. Our highly efficient wine presses enable us to squeeze all the juice from the grapes without crushing their tender seeds, thus adding further to the pure bouquet of our wines.

The entire wine-making process, from wine-growing to bottling, takes place at the Chateau. Traditions are strictly observed. Our cellars, built in the former chapel, can accommodate up to 9000 hectolitres of wine.
