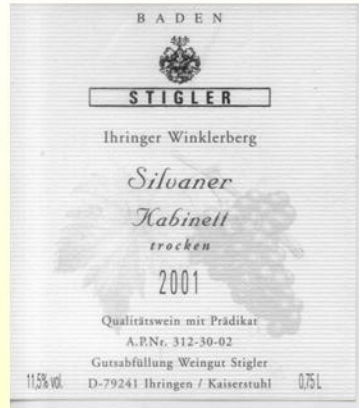


Ihrenger Winklerberg Silvaner Kabinett Trocken 2001
