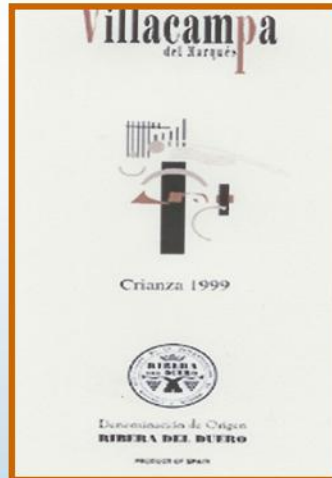


VILLACAMPA Crianza 99



Mainly Tempranillo “Tinta del Pais”

Covered, deep cherry red colour with very slight red-brick tones. In the olfactory passage, a certain amount of primary aromas and another more complex ones like vanilla, leather and hunting are developed. Its vivid acidity and consistent fleshness with excellent tannins let the animal and spicy series through.



D.O Ribera Del Duero

Situated in the Province of Burgos, Ribera del Duero wines are deeply concentrated, richly textured, and among the longest lived of all Spanish red wines. They have about 30,000 acres of vineyards. The soil is generally loose and easily worked. There is a good deal of limestone, and often iron too, which explains the reddish hue of the soil. Vineyards closer to the river are known to have considerable clay content.

Maite Gayero creates a joint venture with the cave Cooperative of Ribera Del Duero, an incredible assemblage. She's the owner for many years of 15 restaurants in Spain where she understands that wine has to be made around the food conception of the country.
