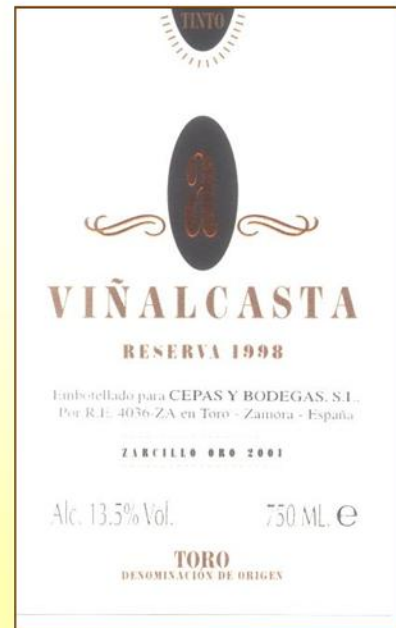


# VINALCASTA RESERVE 2001

100% Tinta de Toro



These 2 years wines have a bright and dark cherry colour with brick-red glints. Nice intensity. It has a complex bouquet that reminds ash and smoke. On the palate it is heavy and complex, round, deep and with a persistent elegance.

## History:

Maite Geijo, the owner, brought a few years ago some hectares in a now well known appellation: D.O. Toro. This has been traditionally considered as a wine growers zone only for self consumption. Things has change now and the main characteristics of those wines that were always an extremely powerful taste, has become in elegant and alive aromas and tastes, maintaining their personality. Their indigenous grapes (a variety of Tempranillo): Tinta de Toro, and their gravel soils made that the Spanish and now International markets for Toro wines have incredibly grown up in the latest years. Maite brought 30 hectares of vines. Ten of them has an average age of thirty years old, and with them we produce a few number of litres from our *Crianza 2000 y Reserva 1998 Viñalcasta*.
