The History

1891 - 1987: Building up the trade. The company was founded in Beaune in 1891. At its beginnings, the company was a small trading house, directed by Jean-Baptiste Bejot.

1988 - **2001**: **From trader to winemaker**. The young 27 year-olds, Vincent Sauvstre, who was driven by the same pioneering spirit as his father Roger, took over the family business in 1988.

2002 - **2010**: **Selected and sustained external growth**. During this period, alongside its organic development, the group undertook a series of acquisitions to strengthen its position in its two strategic businesses: winemaking and wine trading.

2011 - **2012**: **Optimizing production facilities to improve performance**. Driven by the success of its acquisitions and the determination to constantly improve customer service, Vincent Sauvestre undertook a massive building programme to add 11,000 sq. m. to the company's existing facilities.
