The History

Wine-grower collecting on a surface of 18 hectares, I settled in 1987 with 1 hectare, for a passion of a wine to the confluence of the Loire and Vienna.

The propriety cultivates the vines spread over different soils wich make up the Chinon "Appellation Contrôlée".



The Vineyard

A young vineyard (5 to 15 years) planted alongside the Loire. Location : at the confluence of the Loire and the Vienne. Soil : Sandy-gravelly alluvium. Winemaking and aging: Low-temperature fermentation for the first 5 days. Maceration for 8 ot 12 days. Tank aged. Bottled in april



Tasting Notes

100% Cabernet Franc. Deep purple, open, generous damson fruit nose. Rip and supple mouthful with excellent concentration-up-front and fun.



Food Pairing

Pairs well with auttumn and winter vegetable stews and roasts. Asparagus, quiche, roasted vegetable and braised lamb.
