The History

Being soft and elegant wine, la Fleur de Haut-Bages Libéral benefits from the well-known of the Château Haut-Bages Libéral, 5ème Grand Cru Classé de Pauillac. 100% of the production of this 2nd wine is aged in oak barrels in the cellar of Château Haut-Bages Libéral.



The Wine

Owner: Claire Villars-Lurton. Average age of the vines: 30 years. Average yield: 45 hl/ha. Production: 20 to 30 000 bottles/year. Soil: Gunz Graves from the Garonne, river on clay and limestone. Ageing: 5 years. Maturing and making: Traditional maturing in barrels.



Tasting Notes

Cabernet sauvignon: 80 %, Merlot: 17%, Petit Verdot: 3 %. Dense ruby color with nice aromas of sweet blueberries and blackcurrants. Elegant, with rich fruit, well-balanced tannins and a mineral touch. One of the bargains of the vintage.
