The History

The vines are 250 meters above sea level and face East / Southeast. Average age of vines: 40 years. The vines are worked using integrated viticulture. Traditional vinification in thermo-regulated stainless steel. Pre-fermentation temperature controlled cold maceration. Aged in oak barrels for 12 months.

Deep red with purple highlights. Red fruit on the nose which opens with notes of cherry, strawberry and raspberry. Good balance on the palate with a nice structure that holds well on the finish with a little acidity that provides freshness and vanilla and roasted notes all nicely assembled.
