On the nose, fruity and offers a little power, fine texture and fine intensity. It reveals notes of pulpy/juicy blackberry, ripe cassis and hints of violet combined with touches of morello cherry, crushed raspberry and hints of licorice stick, black tea, saffron, fine tonka bean and vanilla bean.
