The History

The Vineyard is located at Eynesse, on the edge of the Bordeaux wine growing district and the Gironde department, just 60 kilometres east of Bordeaux. The estate's 6.5 hectares of Sauvignon Blanc, planted at just 3,600 vines per hectare and aged 22 years, benefit from soils that fit white grape varieties: deep, fertile, with northern exposure.

The Palette reveals a rich and fruity wine, clear and intense in colour with an emerald hue. Intense notes of grapefruit and lemon citrus lead blackcurrant buds in a fine balance between volume, fleshiness and acidity.
