In the reign of Louis XIII, in 1638, a certain Jean de Moy é, Counsellor of the Bordeaux parliament and a noble bourgeois of the town, owned a beautiful sloped gravelly vineyard near the River. This place, as was the tradition, was named after its owner and thus became the “Mont-Moy é.”

Elegant and distinguished, this wine has a very beautiful deep and brilliant robe. It is rich in aromas of blackcurrant and toasted oak. The mouth is fruity with a very good and persistent structure.
