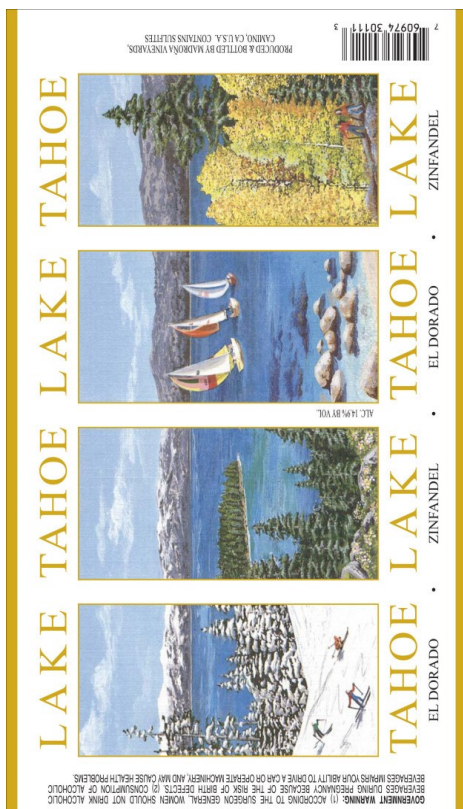

The History

The Madrona wine all started by a pioneer who found an exceptional landscape that is divestible to the hillside vineyard, which was located in El Dorado, California in 1973. It was originally founded by the Senior Bush who wanted to create this unique wine that has great acidity with perfect balance to create this comfort when drinking the wine. This authentic wine was discovered from a 350 year old Madrona tree, which represented the location to grow the best terroir of the Madrona vineyards. These Madrona trees are found in the greatest growing regions through El Dorado, Sierra Foothills AVAs.



The Grape

98.5% Zinfandel, 1.5% Mixed varieties



Tasting

This is a classic bold Zinfandel expressing the Sierra Foothills characters of intense fruit and wonderful depth. The blend this year is almost equally split between our Enyé Vineyards (21 years old) and our Estate Madroña small block (42 years old). The aromas of dark berry, ripe strawberry, and a perfumy floral note marry beautifully with “soy sauce” spiciness and hints of woody minerality. It’s the palate, though, that steals the show. Luscious blackberry floods the entry while cherry and strawberry characters fill in from the sides.
