### **Tasting Note**

The nose is elegant, aromatic and offers a beautiful definition, a fine complexity and harmony. It reveals notes of ripe wild blackberry, wild cassis and small notes of wild raspberry associated with small touches of small berries, lily, violet as well as a hint of tea and spices. The palate is fruity, well-balanced and offers a juicy frame, tension, tension as well as dynamism. On the palate this wine expresses notes of pulpy/juicy raspberry, cassis and small notes of violet associated with touches of blackberry, small wild red fruits as well as a fine hint of plum, black tea, Badiane and sweet spices.
