The History

Purlieu in the literal sense means “the edge of the forest” or “an outlying area.” Symbolically, “purlieu” refers to our approach to winemaking, to exploring the outskirts and navigating the boundaries of what one may expect of a Napa Cabernet Sauvignon. For us, the key to successfully walking that edge lies in maintaining balance: between innovation and tradition, confidence and restraint, depth and refreshment.

Tasting Note

Purlieu’s 2021 vintage from the Beckstoffer Georges III Vineyard showcases the elegant complexity and grace of this renowned Rutherford site. The nose opens with a brilliant harmony of black cherry, savory earth, and minty freshness. In the mouth, the wine dazzles with ripe purple berries, blackcurrant, mocha, and a touch of sleek leather grounded in silky, graphite-scented tannins. Lithe and effortless, the wine lingers with a sweet finish of crushed berries and Amarena cherry.
