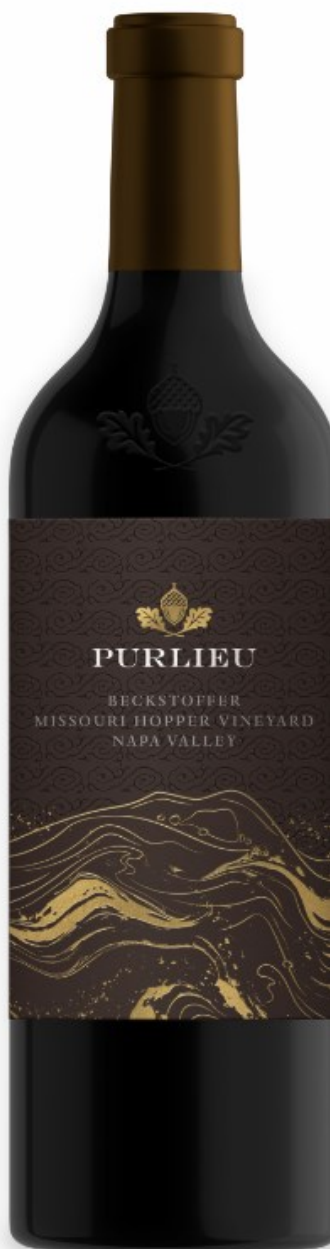

The History

Purlieu in the literal sense means “the edge of the forest” or “an outlying area.” Symbolically, “purlieu” refers to our approach to winemaking, to exploring the outskirts and navigating the boundaries of what one may expect of a Napa Cabernet Sauvignon. For us, the key to successfully walking that edge lies in maintaining balance: between innovation and tradition, confidence and restraint, depth and refreshment.

Tasting Note

The 2021 Purlieu Beckstoffer Missouri Hopper Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is a richly inviting and indulgent expression of its historic Oakville terroir. Bright purple fruits, berry pie, and the whisper of cool river rocks welcome the nose. Brimming with ripe, round purple fruit and juicy cherries, the palate luxuriates in soft, plush tannins with a mineral freshness. Subtle notes of winter savory, flint and honey bring lovely complexity to the mid-palate and long finish of clove, vanilla and boysenberry.
