Wine Making

Burgundy Pinot Noir thrives on stony, well-drained limestone, clay and marl soils at the foot of vineyard slopes, in close proximity to more prestigious crus. Mechanical harvest. Fermentation (alcoholic + malolactic) in stainless steel vats.



Tasting Note

Dark ruby color. The nose opens with a basket of red and black berries (strawberry, cherry, blackcurrant, blueberry), evolving into cooked plum and peppery notes. The palate is lively and structured, with a round and supple backbone. Tannins and fruit go hand in hand, and the chewiness matches the power of the secondary aromas.
