60% Red Grenache | 40% Moscatel



TASTING NOTE

Brilliant pale straw yellow with golden highlights and a luminous, silver rim. Bright, crystal-clear, and vibrant in the glass, reflecting its freshness and elegance. Expressive and layered, opening with vibrant aromas of fresh lemon zest, orange peel, and white grapefruit. The bouquet evolves into notes of ripe white peach, tropical pineapple, mango, and delicate floral hints inherited from the Moscatel, all supported by subtle mineral nuances. The wine opens with a round, silky attack, immediately displaying impressive texture and balance. The mid-palate is generous and refined, revealing flavors of yellow peach, apricot, citrus blossom, and ripe tropical fruit. A lively natural acidity provides freshness and precision, while the Blanc de Noir vinification from Grenache contributes remarkable depth and mouthfeel. The finish is long, elegant, and persistent, leaving lingering notes of candied orange peel, stone fruit, and delicate minerality.
