The History



In 1920, Auguste MAUFRAS, acquired the estate, whose vineyard had an area of 50 hectares. During the war of 1940, property was neglected; and it was only in 1955 that Jean MAUFRAS, undertook the consolidation of the vineyard with noble grape varieties and the renovation of all the cellars and vats, to allow bottling at the chateau, whereas previously, the harvest was sold in barrels. From then on, the vinification was controlled by a confirmed oenologist, Emile Peynaud and then Athanase Fakorellis. Today, this monitoring is carried out by Thomas Duclos, since the purchase of the property by Les Domaines de Moncets.

THE GRAPE



50% Sauvignon blanc , 30% Sémillon 20% Sauvignon gris

TASTING NOTE



Fresh, expressive nose combining citrus fruit, white fruit and floral notes. Lively and taut on the palate, with volume from the clay limestone terroir (65%) and finesse from the sandy gravel (35%). Long, saline and well balanced finish. An elegant white, both precise and delicious.
